## <u>Co-curricular Activities – MME</u>

Dear MME Students and Families,

As you prepare for the upcoming school year, I would like to inform you of the wide variety of co-curricular and enrichment opportunities that are available to you at MME. The various activities are broken down into <u>seasonal</u> and <u>ongoing</u> activities. Seasonal activities typically run after school Monday – Friday for around 8 weeks. Ongoing activities typically meet once per week for several weeks or months. Please read this entire packet to learn more about the different programs available to you. # Participation Fee: \$50.00

ALL students who participate in co-curricular programs **must** pay this fee once a year. This fee is in addition to other fees.

Fees can be paid online

\*Activity Fee: This fee is for the <u>activity</u> only. It includes the cost of transportation to meets/matches and the cost of uniforms and equipment.

**Time:** Athletic activities meet Monday through Friday after school from 4.00- 5:30, although meets/matches usually finish a little later. Parents must pick up students at 5:30 p.m. on practice days. Other activities meet at 4.00pm and usually end between 5.00 and 5.30pm; specific details will be provided by the advisor or coach.

**Insurance is NOT** provided by the school – it must be provided by your family policy.

#### **REFUND POLICY:**

- 1. **Injury** Refund pro-rated.
- 2. **Ineligibility** No refund as student may continue to practice.
- 3. **Quit /Withdrawal from team** Up to 1st contest/game = 75% refund.

  After 1st contest/game = no refund.

Students are required to COMPLETELY register before starting any activity. The registration process is outlined in the Activity Informational letters posted on the MME Activities Website:

### Co-Curricular Grade Level Eligibility Waiver

Participation in co-curricular activities at **Minnetonka High School** will usually be limited to students in grades 9-12. However, the district recognizes that unique or unusual circumstances may exist that might allow students in grades 7-8 to take part in senior high school programs.

Accordingly, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students shall be allowed to request a waiver for possible participation in a high school varsity Co-curricular activity.

Waiver request should be submitted to the Assistant Principal for Student Activities at Minnetonka High School by July 1 (fall activities), October 1 (winter activities), or February 1 (spring activities) to be considered for participation in a high school co-curricular activity.
