Registration Dates

- Students register for electives prior to spring break.
- Schedule change requests are not guaranteed once sections are finalized, as changes may impact class size and staffing needs.

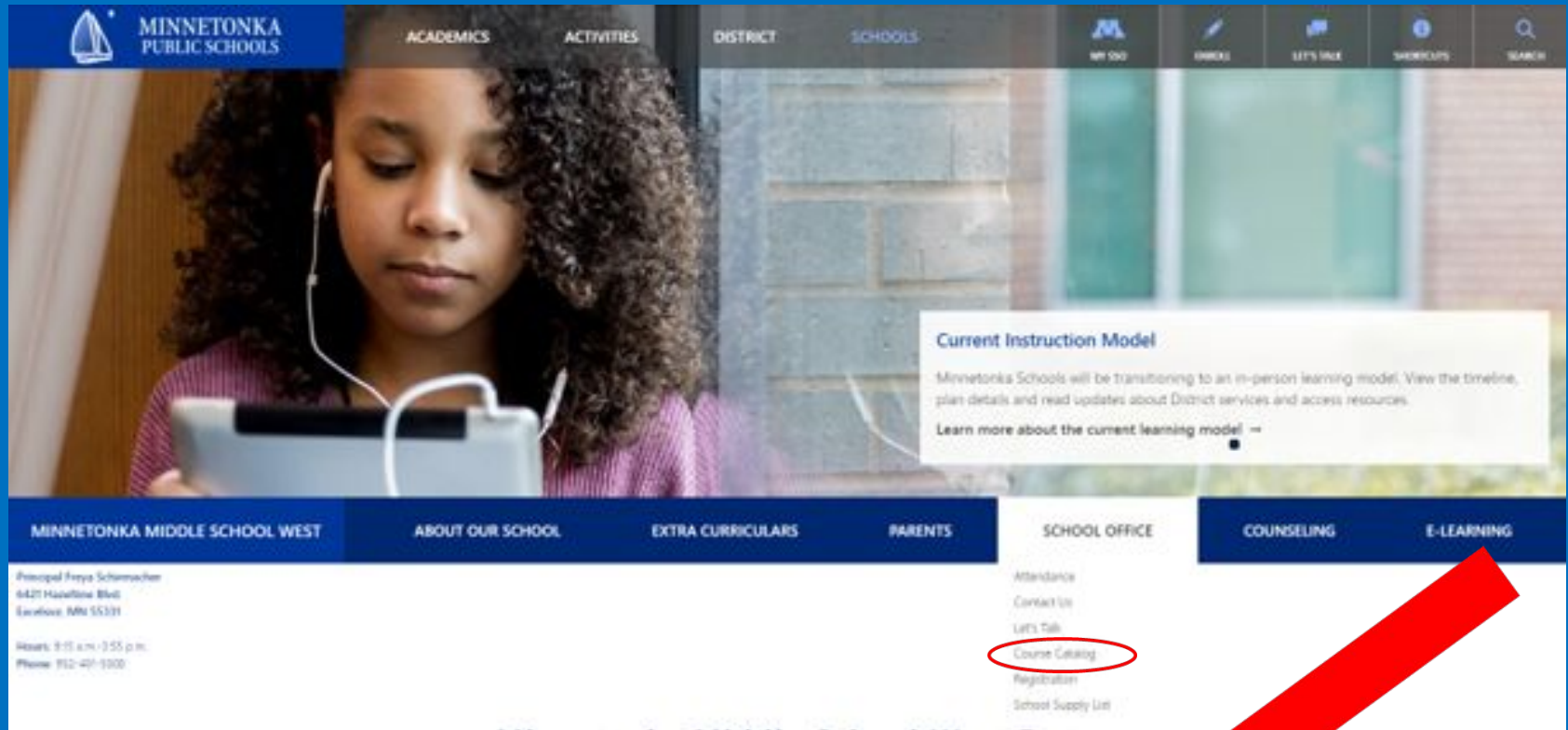

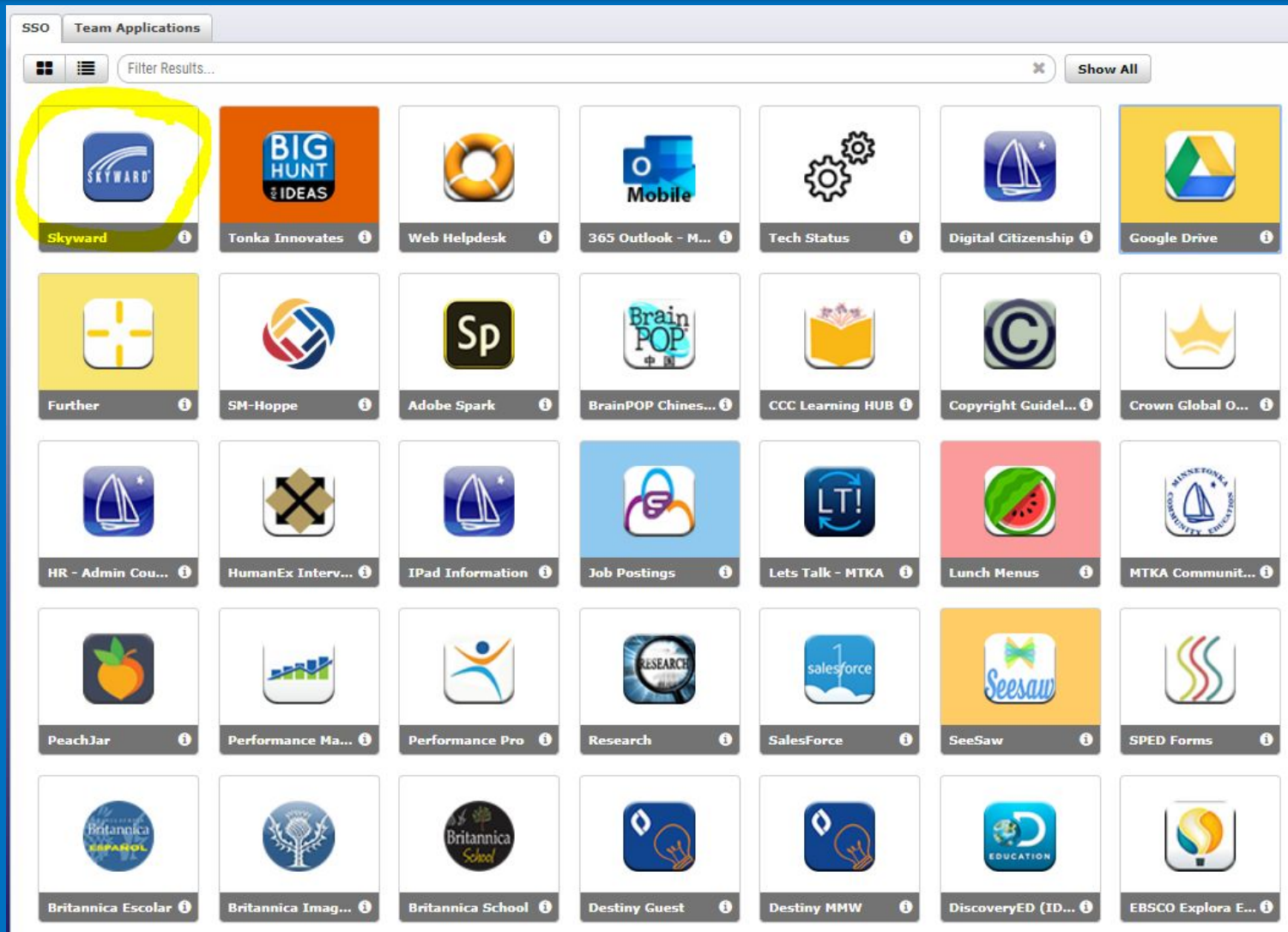
