



## Homebound Tutoring Opportunities

Hello!

We are looking for teachers who are interested in providing homebound tutoring to students. Each year we have students who are in need of homebound instruction because they are unable to attend school for a period of time during the regular school day, which may be due to health issues or other reasons.

If a student is placed on homebound services, they are eligible to receive one hour of instruction from a licensed teacher for each day they are not in school. The scheduling of the hours is flexible in accordance with the teacher's and the student's schedule. The instruction can then be provided at a neutral location such as the library or at the student's home in some cases.
