Welcome to the 2019-20 Home School Year!

The Minnetonka School District provides the forms needed for Homeschool families online.

Packets will be mailed only to those home schools that do not have internet access, and must be requested by the home school principal before September 15, 2019.

In accordance with state law, Minnetonka Public Schools is required to ensure that all school-age children living within the district's boundaries are being educated. The district's primary role is to be certain that all Home Schools comply with state law and to provide the necessary information and forms to each Home School for compliance.

If you determine home-schooling is the best option for your student, please complete the Non-accredited, Nonpublic School Full Report, or the Letter of Intent to Continue Homeschooling, and submit it, either by USPS mail, fax, or email, to Minnetonka Public Schools by October 1, 2019.

- For first-time home-schooled students, Pupil Immunization Record and Testing Information are also required when submitting your **Non-accredited, Nonpublic School Full Report**.
- For home school students previously reported to the district please submit a **Letter of Intent to Continue Home Schooling**.
- If you wish to participate in the MDE nonpublic pupil aids program, you must request the **Student Report for Aids to Nonpublic Students** form from the District's Home School Liaison (email or call), and complete. (Signed on or before September 15, 2019) **Return it, and all forms to the student accounting office by October 1, 2019.**

***Deadlines for returning all forms to the School District are set by the MN Department of Education and will remain the same for the 2019-20 school year.**

Child Find: Minnetonka Schools is committed to locating any child residing within the school district boundaries that has a disability and may be in need of special education services. If you are concerned about your child's educational achievement, language, articulation or social/emotional development and you suspect that your child may have a disability, please contact the Student Support Services at 952-401-5013.

Student Support Services: A home school child with a current Individual Education Program (IEP) plan can receive special education services through shared-time enrollment. Contact the Student Support Services at 952-401-5013 for information about receiving shared-time special education services for a home schooled student.
