

International Studies Overseas Travel (ISOT) Scholarship Application

Scholarship Purpose

The ISOT Scholarship's purpose is to allow Minnetonka students enrolled in the International Studies Program to broaden and deepen their understanding of their partner country and engage in international travel within the context of an academically and culturally enriching experience. Please note that only <u>one</u> scholarship per student will be awarded during his/her time at Minnetonka High School. If you have previously received an ISOT scholarship from the Foundation, please do not re-apply for a second scholarship.

Through generous donations, a fund has been established to provide partial scholarships for this international travel for those students who:

- Express a desire to undertake the travel
- Demonstrate satisfactory progress in the course
- Confirm with their parents signature that they could not otherwise undertake this trip if such funds were not available.

Application Process

In order to apply for an ISOT scholarship of <u>up to</u> \$500, you must complete the five steps outlined below. Incomplete and/or unsigned applications will not be considered.

- 1. Complete Contact Details & Travel Specifics (Home address, phone number, student and parent/guardian e-mail address, country you wish to visit and dates of travel)
- 2. Short Essay of 300 words or less detailing what you have learned from the International Studies Course in the last year. Essay should be typed, 12 point font and double spaced.
- 3. Short essay of 300 words or less explaining how you will benefit from the opportunity to travel to your correspondent's country. Essay should be typed, 12 point font and double spaced.
- 4. Approval of good course standing by your International Studies Teacher
- 5. Signed statement from your legal guardian stating that you have a **financial need** for a scholarship to make it possible for you to travel to your correspondent's country

Applications need to be submitted by the end of Semester 1 (January 18, 2019) in order to be considered.
